1. Call to Order/Welcome: Mrs. Cimaglia called meeting to order at 2:10pm.
2. Approve March's Minutes (needs quorum) – Mrs. Hanson motioned to approve; Ms. Trejo seconded the motion.
3. Principal's Update/Reports: Smooth transition back for students. Crunch time focus for 3rd -5th grade. Fun events coming up for our students. PTO vacant positions are open. A lot of academics going on, students are very focused. This month is autism acceptance (wear blue to celebrate). "Just do it" award- students awarded and 2 students won a poster contest and will be honored at the school board meeting. School theme for next year will be discussed (travel theme, lights, camera, learning, grow together, wild about learning). Once chosen, we will share that out with the community. Working on the budget over the next few weeks and we will discuss the proposed budget by the next meeting. We will adjust the meeting as needed so we can discuss the budget. Proposed and based on enrollment. Losing enrollment district wise but our PSE after care allows us to bring in some funds. The department of Education cuts have not impacted our budget but if it does, we will address at upcoming meetings
 - a. Accountability Funds - \$13,046.09 (\$3,200 pending to be deducted). It would leave \$9,846.09 in the accountability funds.
 - b. SESIR – zero infractions since December
One previous incident so far for 24-25 school year
 - c. Safety and Security We have 2 security officers on our campus now. Mr. Fernandez on campus all week filling in for Officer Nick.
4. PM3 Testing Overview- 4/2 Writing is the first of the big test for 4th-5th grade. K-2nd will take reading May 1st and Math May 2nd



May 7th FAST ELA 3RD-4TH -May 8th 5th FAST- May 13th Math FAST 5th and May 14th FAST Math 3rd-4th. If students have not met the promotion criteria, they will have an opportunity to take an assessment for promotion. No electronics on the assessment day.

5. School Improvement Plan (SIP) Monitoring- Going over the goals: 3-5th 75% meeting proficiency. We will go over the goal in May's meeting. Lowest Quartile in math- working to close that gap so they are proficient by the time we have testing in May. Cephas' got a grant that will help service ESE students to fill in the gaps using Manipulatives. Ms. Scott is providing additional small group instruction and is working with the students to reach the goal. Our goal is that all students will show growth. Teachers are reviewing all the content students learned throughout the year. Equity Updates-It is Asian American and Pacific Islanders month. Ms. Jackson- Autism acceptance month. Kindergarteners will have a sensory station; Panther pals will read books about acceptance and kindness. Students will participate by doing the pledge of allegiance on the morning announcement.
6. 2025-2026 SIP Planning – Once we see the data, we will set the goal and invite the community and staff to participate and give input. The goals are based on where we need to grow. 3rd is usually Reading. Attendance is another area that we will continue working to improve.
