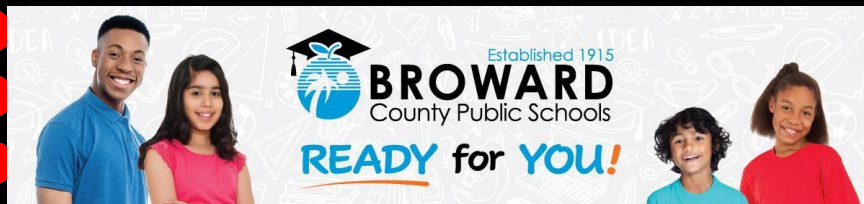

### MONARCH SIGN OUT/SIGN-IN PROCEDURES

All visitors to our campus must present a valid state issued identification. Access to our campus must be via the single point of entry in the main entrance. Visitors will be granted access once they are cleared by our Security Tracking and Response (STAR) System. Students will be permitted to sign out **only if** a parent or individual designated by a parent appears in person. Identification is required.

### IDENTIFICATION POLICY

All Monarch students will be issued an ID that must be worn at all times while on campus. In the event students forget or misplace their identification badges they will be provided with a temporary badge. When the fifth request for a temporary badge is received the student must purchase a new badge for a \$5.00 fee.
