ACCEPTABLE ATTIRE

<u>Colors for Shirts</u> :	White, Burgundy, and Gold (Solid Colors Only) Long or Short Sleeve Polos, Oxfords, or Dress Shirts with Collars
<u>Colors for Bottoms</u> :	Khaki, Black, and Navy Blue (Solid Colors Only-NO JEANS) Khaki, Cargo, Dress Style Pants, Shorts (Mid-Thigh/Knee Length) Capris, Mid-Thigh Skorts, Skirts, and Dress-Styled Jumpers

UNACCEPTABLE ATTIRE

- Unified dress code shirts cannot have large visible designer and/or other brand logos
- Unified dress code shirts cannot be accessorized with ties, vests, over shirts, etc.
- Outer wear cannot conceal unified dress code shirts
- HOODIES and/or pull-over sweatshirts/or sweaters are not permitted
- Only zipper or button-down jackets or sweaters permitted
- Sweatpants, Athletic Pants, Joggers, Jeans or Denim Bottoms
- Leggings/Stretch Pants/Tights
- Clothing with indecent/holes
- Low hanging trousers are UNACCEPTABLE Bottoms must be worn and secured on the waistline
- See-through clothing
- Tutu/Leather skirts
- Bandanas, hats, caps, athletic headbands, and head scarves (unless for religious purpose)
- Sneakers or flat-heeled shoes only. No CROCS or slides.
