These courses, however, may not be considered "honors" for State University Admissions, NCAA Eligibility, or for Bright Futures Scholarship purposes and may not be awarded the extra quality point in these programs' recalculated GPAs. All local honors courses are designated with "LH" in the title.

Opportunities for Dual Enrollment are available through Broward College and the University of Florida.

All students are required to take one course online before graduation.
