

STRANAHAN HIGH SCHOOL Dual Enrollment Eligibility NEW Student Checklist

1. Meet the following Dual Enrollment eligibility requirements:

- ✓ Minimum 3.0 unweighted high school GPA
- ✓ College Level test scores in all areas – English, Reading **and** Math

Placement Test	English	Reading	Math
SAT	25+ (Writing and Language)	24+ (Reading)	24-26.4 (MAT1033) 26.5+ (MAC1105)
ACT	17+ (English)	19+ (Reading)	19-20 (MAT1033) 21+ (MAC1105)
PERT	103+ (Writing) <u>and</u> 106+ (Reading)	106+ (Reading)	114-122 (MAT1033) 123+ (MAC1105)

Note: If students require PERT testing they must first obtain a dual enrollment testing form from the high school counselor after they have completed the BC Online Application (see directions below). Then students must provide a copy of test scores to their high school counselor. The PERT exam is of no cost to the student on the first attempt. Students must pay \$15 for each retake. 2. Obtain a **BC ID Number** and **Institutional Email** by completing the following steps:

- a) Visit www.broward.edu and click on the **Apply Now** button
- b) Click on the **Apply Now** button as indicated under the **New Students** section
- c) Create an **Application Login** and click on **Create Login**
- d) Choose **Enrollment Intention #5 (Dual Enrollment)**
- e) Begin filling in the required fields on the application
- f) For **Date of Graduation**, choose **June** as your MONTH and the YEAR you are graduating
- g) Click on **Submit My Application**
- h) Upon submission, confirmation page will appear with your **BC Student #** and **Email** – **SAVE/PRINT**
- i) Click and **Review all Policies and Requests** – **Your NEW Homepage will then appear**
- j) Your new **Institutional Email** will appear on bottom-right hand side of homepage – Save this info!

3. Print out your Broward College application submission confirmation page along with your Institutional Email and bring to your School Counselor / Magnet Coordinator.

4. Meet with School Counselor / Magnet Coordinator to discuss Eligibility Scores (see above table). If student requires PERT Testing, a Dual Enrollment Testing Form will be given to you by your Counselor / Magnet Coordinator.

5. Provide your counselor with a copy of your **PASSING** PERT Test scores before SHS Deadline below.

6. Give yourself ample time to complete the Enrollment Eligibility items above. If you become eligible, **Dual Enrollment Recommendation Form** must also be completed and submitted to your counselor by the STHS Deadlines below for the semester(s) you wish to enroll.
