




Stranahan High School students in need of a laptop must first complete the <u>Technology Needs Survey</u>.





### Student Attendance During eLearning



"Attendance during eLearning is a new and developing process. Teachers will record student attendance in Pinnacle. Students will be counted in attendance in the learning environment during their scheduled class time. Teachers should be flexible and consider any extenuating circumstances of individual students and may consider other evidence of attendance in these individual cases. Students will be counted as absent when no evidence of the student's online presence can be observed by the teacher during their scheduled class time.

Parents will be notified within 48 hours of a reported absence via a robocall. It is the parent's responsibility to communicate a reason for absence by phone or through the online form available on the traditional school's website (Contact > Report an Absence)."




