

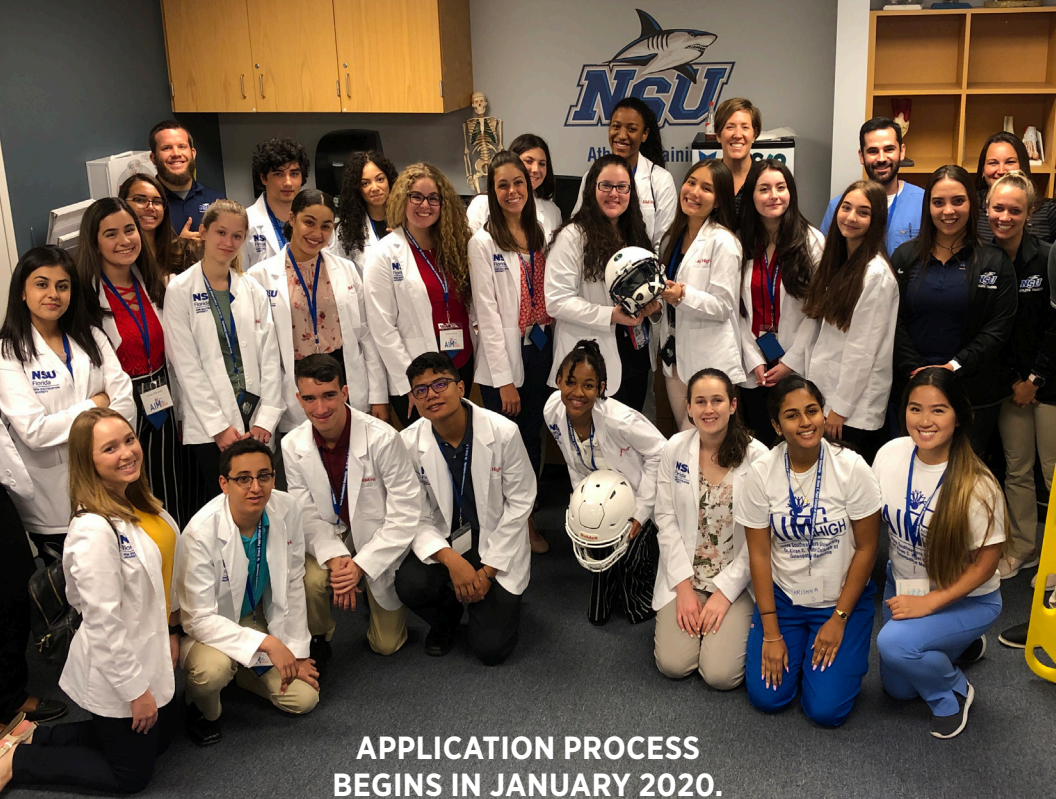
PLAN TO AIM-HIGH
