Self Advocacy

All Self Advocacy classes will cover:

- laws to protect students while in school and at work
- active listening techniques

Work Readiness

All Work Readiness classes will cover:

- resume building

- time management
- enthusiasm
- mock interviews.

The 50 Hour Class will include Career Exploration on topics like:

- Robotics
- Police & Security
- Automotives
- Animals

How do you sign up?

Contact your VR counselor or local VR office to start this process.

Classes are closed captioned.

Classes are first come first serve upon completion of paperwork.

Students must be between the ages of 14-21, in school with an IEP or 504 plan and meet VR eligibility requirements. Students must complete the Pre-Assessment, Post-Assessment, and Timesheets in order to receive their stipend.
