Broward College Dual Enrollment

Dual Enrollment

The Dual Enrollment Program at Broward College (BC) is an accelerated program that allows eligible public/charter, private and home school secondary students to take postsecondary coursework and simultaneously earn both high school and college credits, saving both time and money! Dual Enrollment students are exempt from the payment of application fees, tuition, and laboratory fees. College courses are offered at BC campuses and centers, including the Broward College Online campus, and at several high school campuses.

Early Admission

Early Admission, a form of dual enrollment, allows eligible high school senior students to enroll in at least 12 credits per term, Fall and Spring, and maintain a college GPA of 2.0 or greater. Early admission students wishing to matriculate to BC will need to submit their final high school transcript showing their graduation date.

Course Scheduling:

For students participating in Dual Enrollment, please note that you must have 7 courses (not including your Personalization period). If you are taking 1 course off-campus, you will have 6 classes at JPT plus your personalization period (unless if Junior or Senior Privilege). If you are taking 2 courses off-campus, you will have 5 classes at JPT plus your personalization period (unless if Junior or Senior Privilege). Keep this in mind when selecting your course times!!

For students participating in Early Admissions, please remember that you must maintain at least 12 college credits during each semester (Fall and Spring) to participate in this program. The maximum approved credits are 15.
