**SUBJECT: COMMERCIAL FOOD DELIVERY SERVICES FOR STUDENTS**

A variety of commercial food delivery services, such as UberEATS™, allow the use of mobile phone applications to place orders from local restaurants with food items being delivered to the requested location. In the past, students have utilized these services to receive “takeout food” delivered to their school during the school day.

Commercial food deliveries to the school are having a negative impact to the front office and security staff, disrupting the school day. Unauthorized visitors are not allowed on Broward County Public Schools property for the delivery of student ordered meals. Administrators must enforce all campus safety procedures for the benefit of the entire school community.

Effective immediately, school personnel are not permitted to accept commercial food deliveries for students. Broward County Public Schools are closed campuses. Students are not permitted to order food items to be delivered to school campuses.
