Broward College has COMPLETELY REDONE their Dual Enrollment Recommendation Form, therefore it is imperative that you review the email/diagram below and read documents attached in their entirety.


There will no longer be any physical paperwork to submit or pdf's to try and format, however there will be a multi-step electronic Recommendation Form that must be completed and approved by 1st - the student, 2nd - the parent, 3rd - the School Counselor, and finally 4th - a BC representative.

Directions for accessing the Recommendation Form can be found on the *DE Form Student Guide* Attachment in this email.

Prior to completing the BC Dual Enrollment Recommendation Form, students must already have their BC ID and BC Email Address from the online BC application they submitted. Students must also have their qualifying test scores OR have already been participating in Dual Enrollment during Fall Term 2020.

Both the student and parent portion MUST be completed and to the School Counselor by Thursday, October 1st, 2020.

Please know that until you have received an email from Broward College approving you to register for specific classes, you will not be able to sign up for your classes when **Registration begins on October 28th, 2020.** 



A few reminders when submitting your list of course selections for School Counselor approval:

- All current Dual Enrollment/Early Admissions initial and continuing eligibility information and state approved course list can be found at <a href="https://www.broward.edu/dual">www.broward.edu/dual</a>.
- Check for pre-requisites and/or co-requisites to make sure you are eligible to take course.
- In the Comment section for students Note any passing AP/AICE exam scores if you are using as pre-requisite into a course.
- In the Comment section for students Note if any courses listed are taken at JPT
- Review both high school and college credit awarded for each course.
- Please provide a list of approximately 8 courses typed on your form, as you may only choose from approved courses when registration begins (see state approved dual enrollment course list at www.broward.edu/dual).
- IT IS THE STUDENT'S RESPONSIBILITY TO STAY INFORMED OF ALL SCHOOL EVENTS AND DEADLINES (EXAMPLES INCLUDE BUT ARE NOT LIMITED TO -PROM, GRADBASH, CAP & GOWN, GRADUATION/ REHEARSALS, BRIGHT FUTURES/FAFSA, SCHEDULING, FIELD TRIPS, ETC.)
