Responsibilities of Students

- Attend school daily.
- Be prepared for class and complete assignments.
- Follow the Code of Student Conduct
- Accept and respect individual differences and people
- Notify school staff about any dangerous behavior, bullying or activity that occurs on school grounds, or off school grounds when it may result in disruption to the educational setting
- Keep parents informed of school-related issues and ensure communications are brought home

Student I.D.'s

- ID Badges must be always worn around your neck and visible.
 - Must be most recent badge with your photo, name, and student number
- Teachers-do not allow students into class without plastic or temporary I.D.
 - Send to security desk in front of cafeteria with a pass if they do not have one.
- I.D.'s are to be worn at outside school events

Attendance

- Come to school daily. All days are important.
- Parent or Guardian must call the attendance hotline within 2 days of your absence to be excused.
- Arrive to school and be IN class before 7:40am.
- Choose the quickest path to class during the school day. This may not be the same one as your friends ©
- 3rd Tardy=detention
- 5+ Tardy = multiple detentions
- Arriving to class 10 or more minutes after the bell rings will be considered a class cut and result in B.L.C. for the period.

Attendance Continued

- Students should not ask to leave the classroom within the first and last 10 minutes of class.
- Study Hall passes should be written by the teacher who is requesting to see you and signed by the study hall teacher.
- Tutoring Passes are purple and should be given to the student prior to the tutoring period
- All bathrooms are color coded. Do not end up in a bathroom that does not match your teachers pass.

Lunch Expectations

Only the Cafeteria and Patio areas are available to students during both lunches. Anyone identified in any other areas will be redirected and/or may receive consequences.

You must receive a Media Center pass from the security desk to go during lunch. You may not bring food with you.

Dress Code

Broward County School Board Dress Code Policy will be strictly enforced. Violators will be offered alternative wear as appropriate, however, Administration and Security will make the final determination on what is appropriate wear at Taravella High School.

Refusal to comply with dress code is subject to disciplinary action.

Bystander/Inciting Disturbance

Students standing and filiming, posting on social media, or hyping up a fight will receive consequences for **Inciting a Distrubance**-per BCPS Discipline Matrix

Electronics Policy

-Students are not allowed to use any type of electronic devices during instructional time, unless they are being used for instructional purposes as determined by the teacher.

-Only one earbud/headphone may be used for safety reasons

-Electronic devices are **YOUR** responsibility and JPT staff will not allocate time and resources to lost devices.

Zero Tolerance

Taravella High School has zero tolerance for the violation of school and Broward County School Board policies and rules.

- **♦ Students who bring a firearm or weapon to school, any school function, or onto any school sponsored transportation or are found in possession of a firearm at school will be suspended for 10 days, expelled for at least 1 year, and will be arrested for a felony.**
- ♦ Other major infractions which could lead to suspension or expulsion include:
- 1. Drugs
- 2. Weapons
- 3. Fighting
- 4. Theft/Destroying Property
- 5. Bullying or any type
- 6. Verbal/Physical Assault
- 7. Threats/Harassment
- 8. Inappropriate social media postings
- 9. Sexting
- 10. Other criminal acts
