Attending all 30 hours will maximize your benefits & earn you as much as \$125!

*Students must attend all 30 hours of camp to receive the full stipend of \$125. If hours attended are less than 30, the stipend amount will be reduced to the lowest 10-hour increment: 10 hours: \$37.50; 20 hours: \$75.

Students ages 14-21 who are currently enrolled in school and have an IEP or 504 plan are able to participate in Career Camps, a week-long virtual workshop helping students discover a multitude of career possibilities available after high school. Because we change our curriculum every season, each career camp is unique. So even if you have already participated in a camp, you can join us again for a new experience!

Pre-ETS service categories covered in these camps:

- Work Readiness Training: interview training, job search, resume building, dressing for success.
- **Self-Advocacy:** practicing advocating for yourself, soft-skills training, communication, and team building activities.
- Work Based Learning Experience: virtual worksite tours, and career talks from industry leaders including Q&A sessions.
- Post-Secondary Education Counseling: learning about post-secondary options and certificate programs.
