Observed 2 dead roaches under shelving in paper storage area. Remove dead roaches. Roaches were removed and area was cleaned by PIC Tiffany Goodrum. Outer doors to dumpster area not vermin proof, opening observed between door base and floor, weather strip missing. Prevent entry of vermin.
