- 6. Intend to enroll as a full-time undergraduate student in a University, Vocational / Technical Institution, and/or Community/Junior College no later than the fall of 2023.
- 7. Exhibit strong personal character traits that demonstrate a sense of **ambition**, **motivation**, **responsibility**, and **conscientiousness**.
- 8. Be free of any outstanding obligations at WBHS
- 9. Not be involved in any disciplinary action at WBHS during the 2022-2023 school year.
