UF Online Dual Enrollment Program – Fall 2015

The UF Online Dual Enrollment courses is available for high achieving high school students. These fully online courses are taught by University of Florida (UF) faculty and provide students with a rigorous college learning experience. Students may take up to 2 courses. Eligible students must have a **3.5 unweighted GPA** or higher and a **minimum score on a college readiness exam - 21 ACT, 142 PSAT, or 1490 SAT**. **The registration deadline for the Fall term is May 29th**.
