



# MUSEUM ON THE MOVE 2021-22

FREE Virtual Field Trips and Educator Resources for Broward County Schools

Museum on the Move is an innovative education program that invites Broward County students to NSU Art Museum. The program enhances learning and increases engagement by involving students in interactive virtual programs of the Museum's exhibitions and hands-on art activities based on principles of STEAM (science, technology, engineering, art, math) along with 21st Century learning skills. These programs combine observations and discussions of the artwork where students learn to recognize mediums, materials, and the artistic process. The art activities are designed for students to recognize how different elements function together to express ideas and emotions, solve visual dilemmas, and realize artists' intentions.



MOTM fieldtrip visits have been adapted into virtual offerings that can be tailored to the current needs of the virtual classroom. Several virtual learning modules are available to choose from, each specially designed to suit your teaching needs: Virtual Zoom Tours (one per semester), Elements of Art prerecorded video series includes art talk and activity, mini art making videos and printable lessons and activities. During their encounter, students participate in visually stimulating experiences that for many are often a first introduction to an art museum.

### MODULE 1- Museum on the Move: Elements of Art Series or Principles of Design

MOTM Elements of Art Series consist of seven pre-recorded videos and activities that can be integrated within the classroom curriculum. This series also includes a Student Art Kit for each child, and a return pass to visit the museum with free admission.

### **HOW IT WORKS**

- Exclusive YouTube video links delivered directly to your inbox for each of the seven 20-30 minute episodes.
- Our Educators leads a lesson on the featured Element of Art or Principles of Design, engaging students in an in-depth critical thinking exercise that teaches them how to look at art and identify the elements used by the artist.
- Our Educators leads a step-by-step art activity immediately following the discussion.
- Videos offer the flexibility to work alongside with our educators, pausing when needed, or watching fully and then begin the art-making process.
- You will receive Museum on the Move Student Art Kits for each student, filled with the necessary materials to complete the projects during the seven-session series.
- Inside the Student Art Kits, students will also find a Free Return Pass, which grants free admission to the Museum for 1 student and 1 adult.




















#### **MODULE 2- Museum on the Move: Live Tours**

MOTM Live Tours revive the interactive component MOTM tours. As in the tours that take place at the Museum, students are able to interact using Visual Thinking Strategies. These in-depth tours concentrate on subjects represented in the Museum's exhibitions. This series also includes a Student Art Kit for qualifying schools.

### **HOW IT WORKS**

- A live tour for the desired date and time will be scheduled, and a Zoom link will be sent.
- During the Live videocall, students are led through a virtual 360-degree tour and presentation of one of the Museum's exhibitions with a Museum educator.
- Following the virtual tour, a Museum educator will lead the students in a STEAM-based art activity inspired by the exhibition.
- You will receive Museum on the Move Student Art Kits for each student, filled with the necessary materials to complete the projects.
- Inside the Student Art Kits, students will also find a Free Return Pass, which grants free admission to the Museum for 1 student and 1 adult.



## **MODULE 3- Other virtual offerings**

Additional virtual offerings include exhibition Teacher Guides, mini art making videos and printable lessons and activities.
