Dear Parents and Guardians of Students of current 8<sup>th</sup> graders:

Congratulations! Your student will be going to high school! To be sure your child is properly enrolled in high school, you will need to re-register your child and provide proof of where you live. To do this you will need one document from each of the columns in the chart below:

Column A	Column B
a. Current telephone or electric bill in the name of the person registering the child	g. Automobile insurance
b. Mortgage statement	h. Current Florida Driver's License / Florida Identification card
c. Notarized lease agreement with name, address and phone number of leaser	i. Cellular telephone bill
d. Mortgage commitment	j. Credit card statement
e. Home purchase contract including specified closing date, with copy of deed to be provided within 60 days of closing date	k. Bank account statement
f. Homestead exemption card	l. United States Postal Service confirmation of address change request
	m. Declaration of Domicile form from the County Records Department

You will also need to complete the Registration Form and Emergency Contact Form. Both of these forms are included with this letter.

To summarize, four documents are needed to re-register your child for high school.

1. An item from Column A
2. An item from Column B
3. Completed Registration Form
4. Completed Emergency Contact Form

Many high schools are meeting with parents and students to welcome the students to high school and help parents with this re-registration process. Re-registration is important, because your student cannot attend classes until this process is complete.
