

CONSENT TO DISCLOSE STUDENT INFORMATION TO BROWARD COUNTY JUVENILE FIRESETTER PREVENTION AND INTERVENTION PROGRAM / LOCAL FIRE AUTHORITY

The Broward County juvenile Firesetter Prevention and intervention Program (JFPIP) is a program for children and their families in Broward County that provides fire safety education, community outreach presentations, firesetter assessment, and firesetter intervention workshops.

Training topics include:

- Starting a fire
- > The misuse of fire
- Initiating bomb threats
- Creating destructive devices (bombs)
- Pulling a fire alarm without the threat of fire (deliberate false alarm)
- Smoking on campus that results in fire alarm activation (including e-vapor devices)
- Any reason that includes the child's curiosity or involvement with fire as a potential endangerment to safety of life or damage of property.

Broward County Public Schools (BCPS) works in collaboration with the local fire safety agencies to ensure students who would benefit from JFPIP are effectively linked.
