Please read the following policies and sign below to acknowledge.

1. In order to participate in Grad Bash 2022, students must have an overall unweighted GPA of 2.0 (or higher), 40 service hours, less than 10 full days or 40 class absence during 2nd semester, and be on track towards graduation.
2. All obligations must be paid in full before a student can purchase a Grad Bash ticket.
3. Students that have been externally suspended during the 2022 school year are not eligible to purchase a ticket, students externally suspended after purchasing a ticket will forfeit their ticket without a refund.
4. No refunds/exchanges/transfers will be issued for any reason once a ticket is purchased.
5. Student must follow all rules established by Universal Studios Orlando.
6. Students must attend all classes and not be tardy on April 29th 2022 or they will not be able to attend and will not receive refund.
7. Students must follow the dress code established by Universal Studios Orlando.
8. All students will be subject to search before boarding the buses.
9. No food or drink will be permitted on buses.
10. The school is not responsible for any items left on buses.
11. Students must have a current SBHS School Senior ID.
12. Students are responsible for purchasing food and drink at rest stops and at Universal Studios Orlando.

ITINERARY:

April 29, 2022

1. All attendees (students and chaperones) will report to the Gym at South Broward High School at 10:00 a.m.
2. Students are to sit in the section of the bleachers designated for their bus to get checked in and have belongings searched. Students must be checked in on bus roster and may not leave the gym without permission from either Mrs. Lehman and/or Mr. Pluim. They MUST have a current SBHS School Senior ID; if not they should be sent to Mrs. Lehman.
3. Chaperones MUST search all participants prior to boarding the bus. There will be zero tolerance for tobacco, alcohol, drugs (prescription or over-the-counter) or weapons of any kind - BE VERY VIGILANT OF VAPOR PENS. Students must be in dress code (see attached). Their bags may be no larger than a sheet of printer paper and the pillows / blankets must be small couch size items - not full bedding.
4. We will begin boarding the buses (one at a time) at 11:00am and depart from SBHS at 11:00am.
5. All movies shown on the buses MUST be PG-13 / school appropriate.
6. We will make one 60 minute rest stop for attendees to use the restrooms, get food, and stretch. Location will be determined by the lead bus driver and based on rest stop congestion.

April 30, 2022

The parks will close at 2:00 a.m. on Saturday. Chaperones are asked to return to the buses as promptly as possible to begin student check-in. Buses will depart the park promptly at 2:30 a.m. We will return to the parking lot at SBHS at approximately 6:30 a.m., Saturday, April 29th 2022. Please advise students 30 minutes before arrival at SBHS to call or arrange for a ride home. The senior parking lot will be locked after school on Friday the 29th and reopened when we return in the morning. SBHS is not responsible for vehicles parked in the areas surrounding the school.

DRESS CODE GUIDELINES

We want all participants to be comfortable during Grad Bash. This document will provide details on what is acceptable and not acceptable to wear to Grad Bash. Universal Orlando Resort's Security team strictly enforces all dress code regulations for Grad Bash.

What is OK to wear to Grad Bash

Accessories

- Sunglasses, hats, belts, jewelry, and headbands

Bags/Purses

- All bags and purses must be under the size of 8.5" x 5.5" (half a sheet of paper)
- Drawstring nylon bags are allowed as long as they fall within the 14" x 18" size requirement
- Fanny packs are encouraged

Tops/Shirts

- Casuals tops and blouses are permitted for girls
- No midriff shirts, shirt sleeves must be 3" wide, no halter tops
- T-shirts and button downs are permitted for guys
- Brand name (i.e. Nike, Adidas, Under Armour, etc.) are allowed
- No undershirts
- Jackets are allowed (no school jackets)

Bottoms

- Jeans, leggings, running shorts, shorts, and skirts are permitted for girls
- Excessive holes/ shreds on jeans are not allowed
- Leggings cannot be sheer or of see through material
- Running/athletic shorts shall be no shorter than mid-thigh
- Shorts shall be no shorter than mid-thigh

Dresses

- Dresses and rompers are permitted
- Dresses must be mid-thigh in length
- Rompers must be mid-thigh in length and sleeves must be 3" wide
- Spandex bodysuits will not be permitted

What is NOT OK to wear to Grad Bash

Girls

- Clothing that exposes excessive portions of skin that may be viewed as inappropriate (bikini tops, bikini bottoms, crop tops, extreme low-cut tops)
- Clothing with obscene, offensive language or graphics
- Area codes displayed on clothing
- Clothing with excessive holes or shredding
- Clothes that are too tight or revealing
- Visible undergarments
- Tank tops, undershirts, sleeveless tops (less than 3 inches in straps)
- Tops that show midriff or cleavage
- Short shorts showing too much skin or shredded to high. All shorts must be no shorter than mid-thigh.
- Dress, skirt, and romper hemlines must be no shorter than mid-thigh
- Nylon basketball shorts
- Accessories such as chains, spiked collars, studded/spiked belts, or including sharp objects
- High school team name, logo, or mascot
- Jerseys of any kind (including college and professional)
- Large backpacks or purses larger than 8.5" x 5.5"
- Matching or like attire
- Spandex body suits

Boys

- Clothing that exposes excessive portions of skin that may be viewed as inappropriate
- Clothing with obscene, offensive language or graphics
- Area codes displayed on clothing
- Clothing with excessive holes or shredding
- Clothing that is too tight
- Visible undergarments
- Tank tops, undershirts, sleeveless tops (less than 3 inches in the straps)
- Pants falling below the waist
- Accessories such as spiked collars, studded/spiked belts, chains hanging from neck, belt, or pocket or attached to a wallet, or including sharp objects
- High school team name, logo, or mascot
- Jerseys of any kind (including college and professional)
- Nylon basketball shorts
- Large backpacks larger than 8.5" x 5.5"
- Matching or like attire
