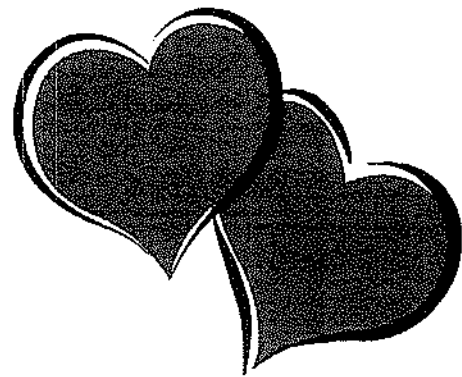

9. SAF Meeting was opened at 7:38 am

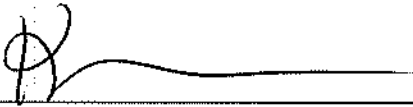
