# PARENT DROP OFF & PICK UP GUIDELINES

- Parents may drop off or pick up students **ONLY** in designated area at the front of the school.
- The back lot is reserved for bus transportation and staff parking ONLY.
- It is a safety hazard to drop off students on the streets near the school.
- When dropping off or picking up students, please form one lane nearest to the curb.
- Pull all the way forward to the end of the drop off area before stopping.
- Please ensure that your child(ren) are ready to leave the vehicle as soon as you stop.
- Drop off students on the curb side only, not in the parking lot.
- Do not park or leave vehicle unattended in the drop off lanes.
- Please avoid using cell phones while driving in the drop off area.
- Parents who bring their students to school after 8:00 am MUST park in the assigned parking area, escort their children into the front office, and sign them into school.

#### Early Dismissl-

- Parents or guardians signing out students early from school must go to the main office with a picture ID. Students will only be released to individuals whose name is listed on the student's dismissal card.

## **SAFETY REMINDERS**

All school employees and students are required to wear name badges at all times while in the building. This procedure will eliminate the possibility of unknown persons on campus. All substitutes and visitors will be subject to the same rule.





### **ATTENDANCE POLICY**

- All students' absences must align with the eight (8) reasons allowed for absences, as outlined in the Attendance Policy and in the Code of Student Conduct.
- Parents must state reason (from approved list) for absence when they call in or write a note to report a student's absence.
- Absences can only be excused if they correspond with one of the eight (8) allowed reasons.

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## UNIFORM POLICY

Students are required to dress in unified colors. **BOTTOMS**:

Colors- Khaki/Tan or Navy

<u>Styles-</u> "Dockers" style – long, straight-leg pants, Capri pants, knee-length walking shorts. "Polo" style dress, jumpers, skirts, skorts, and tennis skirts with shorts attached (with or without pleats) All of the forementioned items must be longer than mid-thigh, no drawstring or oversized pants, no lycra or spandex. Belts should be worn for pants or shorts with belt loops.

#### TOPS:

<u>**Colors-</u>** Royal Blue, Navy, White, Light Blue, Gray and Pastel Yellow. Shirts should be solid color, or Coconut Palm logo shirts (these can be purchased through the PTA).</u>

<u>Styles-</u>Collared "Polo" style (with or without school logo), long or short sleeved. No tank tops or midriffs of any kind no lycra or spandex.

<u>Shoes</u>- Athletic shoes are recommended, however, students must follow School Board Policy regarding footwear.

**PROHIBITED:** jeans, thonged sandals, flip-flops, slippers and zoris.

Students out of uniform will receive a written warning, and after the 3rd warning, the student will receive a 1- hour after school detention.
