We are looking for a secretary to take minutes in our meetings please let us know if you are interested. For those of you that are new, SAC is the improvement plan of the school using research. Last year we ordered math manipulatives, white boards, novels, Heggerty curriculum, and we continue supporting teachers and students needs.

Principal updates. Mrs. Sierra welcome everyone.

- We had summer school this summer and I would like to give credit to the custodial work before school returned on the 21st. The office work great during the summer. PTA also contributed to our media center space; they supported the creation of the mural by the desk area.

- Our office got vinyl to update the main office.
- We do have new printers for every teacher this year as a donation from PTA. Those donations go directly to the classrooms. Our next project is to add promethean boards to all classrooms. This alleviate the use of technology in the classroom, it could be use as an interactive tool.
- Fox Mar Pictures is our new vendor for pictures in school.
- Our IND Program was reduced by one class. Our after-school care program is run by school district.
- APEX is our fundraiser this year.
- School lunch is free for everyone.
- 2023 School Grade 468 points. We did a great job and there is space for improvement. We did see gains in reading and math. We did 5 points above in proficiency. 71% of our students went up a level. 59% ELA learning Gains of lowest 25%. Math, 13 points above of 73% proficiency students. 76% math learning gains and 67% math learning gains lowest 25%. Science went down, 47% proficiency 9 points down. Continue to follow ELD scope and sequence for Science Focus on Hands-On learning and application or skills.
- What is new for this year. Two new reporting categories for the upcoming year. 3rd grade proficiency. Total of 900 points. Writing component, it is another 100 points, and it is a separate component. 558 or higher=A.
- Last year 4th and 5th grades were practice field in writing. Students must read multiple passages then write an essay based on what they read.
- The Science of Reading is part of our curriculum. Decoding (word recognition), language comprehension to reach reading comprehension. Building that background knowledge, phonological awareness, word recognition, before moving on.
- We are doing some progress monitoring district wide. I-Ready is back and adjust to the new standards. Reading and Math diagnostic will be done by September 15 every student will be tested as a base line. Then we will start on September 18 with monitoring.
Question: is there a contract to continue the program? We are not sure of how long the contract is. I-Ready has the diagnostic, personalized instruction, standards mastery,

literacy tools, learning games and fluency flight available for fluency, it is similar reflex mat. Diagnostic 1 will be from September to October then growth monitoring.

Mrs. Glancy welcomes everyone.

- School-Wide Behavior Expectation. SOAR poster around our schools. The poster will be hanged in classroom with students' expectations. The SPBP plan from last year shows data about referrals. Our last year 4th graders had a lot of referrals and most of it was happening during lunch. They needed cooping strategies and support using words. We would like to decrease the ratio of students who had referrals according to our population. We would like to keep our goal of 90% and above. The year before we had a decreased-on incidents from 74 to 39 this year. Current top 3 non-classroom locations were playground and cafeteria. We would like to strengthen our numbers from the classroom, our tier 1 classroom management strength. Teacher may use minilessons in the classroom and assign them online. We are trying to decrease our referrals by 10 % with in the classroom and cafeteria. Teachers go over school expectations daily, before breaks and when they come back from breaks. We are going to keep our complement charts to earn outside recess. We also have our regal eagles that earns treasure box rewards for doing the right thing. No SESIR events for the first week of school. We will have two fire drills; two lock downs drills and one tornado drill this month then it will be every month.
