During the summer, please have your student read Mark Twain's novel, The Adventures of Huckleberry Finn. There are several versions of the book available at the public library; however, the novel is also available online for free at <https://www.gutenberg.org/ebooks/76>. A hard copy can also be purchased for under \$10 at: <https://store.doverpublications.com/0486280616.html>. If you do purchase a hard copy, you may donate it to the school when you are done, if you wish.

In addition to reading The Adventures of Huckleberry Finn, your student will complete two assignments. These will be their first major grades, so students must take this seriously. The first component of the project is a Dialectical Journal. The second component is a collage. (It can be created by hand or computer.) Please see the attachments for the details of the project, template and the grading rubric.

Students should submit their projects no later than Friday, August 23, 2019 to the Dropbox in their "Class of 2020" Course in D2L. (This due date is for ALL Class of 2020 students, regardless of when they take English during the school year.) For the collage, students should take a picture of their artwork to submit to the dropbox in D2L as well as bring it to school.

Your student should be fully aware of the summer reading and the details of the project as I went to all of the classes during the last week of school. They were also emailed the documents as well.
