This packet will be due when we return from Spring Break.

- 1. Read "Humans Need to Explore Outer Space" and answer the Assessment Practice.
 - a. <u>Circle</u> the <u>author's claim</u> in the text. <u>Underline evidence</u> to support the claim.
- 2. Read "Let Robots Take to the Stars" and answer the Assessment Practice.
 - a. <u>Circle</u> the <u>author's claim</u> in the text. <u>Underline</u> <u>evidence</u> to support the claim.
- 3. Complete the chart under "Analyze the Prompt".
 - a. Be sure to read the writing prompt thoroughly on page 300 first.
- 4. Plan your essay by completing the tables under "Plan Your Argument".
 - a. Identify your claim, 3 reasons, and supporting evidence.
- 5. Identify the counterclaim under "Address Opposing Claims".
 - a. Your goal is to convince the reader that your claim is valid.
- 6. Write your essay on the lined paper.
 - a. One paragraph for your *introduction*, 3 paragraphs for your *body* and one paragraph for your *conclusion*.
