Before entering or attending school in-person or virtually (kindergarten through twelfth grade) each child must provide a Florida Certification of Immunization (DH 680 form)*, documenting specific vaccinations, which can be found at:

Seventh Grade:

In addition to kindergarten through twelfth grade vaccines, students entering or attending seventh grade must complete the following:

- One dose of tetanus-diphtheria-pertussis (Tdap) vaccine in grades seven through twelve
- An updated DH 680 form to include Tdap, must be obtained for submission to the school.


HAZEL HEALTH
