- Welcomes and introduces all Assistant Principals, Curriculum Leaders, Behavioral Support Specialists, Testing and Cambridge Coordinators, Reading Chair, and ESE and ESOL Coordinators
- Nova High School is almost fully staffed with Ms. Knowles (Director of School Counseling) and SRGT. Ellis (NJROTC Instructor) starting in September
- Thanks leadership team for commitment to mission and students, Ms. Awodafeju thanks audience for attending

5:50PM – Ms. Awofadeju: School Grade

- We received a grade of an "A" for the 2021-2022 school year
- A presentation was shared highlighting the school breakdown by subgroup performance, how Nova High compared to other schools in the Innovation Zone, Traditional High Schools, Traditional High Schools within the Central Region, how Nova High ranked regarding proficiency levels across Broward County, Advanced Placement Exams results, Cambridge Exams (AICE) results
- Ms. Awofadeju thanks committee for support of teachers and students last school year, various initiatives
- Introduced the new theme for the year, "Keep Rising Together"
- Ms. Kwak says thank you and gives kudos to all teachers and the leadership team for their hard work during a difficult year

6:02PM – Ms. Awofadeju: Principals Report

- Gave a report on how the Media Center was moving along
 - o Expected to be completed either September or October
- Bldg 13 and building 14, AC and fire safety is still being worked on
- Bldg 15 more work still needs to be done
- The work in culinary has not begun and we are waiting on a start date
 - o Monies have come back to the school to assist the renovating of the room
- We are happy to report that teachers and students are rocking and rolling in their classes, where all students are engaged, and teachers are teaching. Focus on TEACHING AND LEARNING (Keep Rising Together)
- There has been a decrease in anticipated enrollments, of which, has been seen across the district
 - The school counseling department have been doing a great job balancing classrooms
 - o Ms. Awofadeju introduces the school counselors
- Thank you to Mr. Hively for his work with athletics and activities
- Rock the Block was introduced, club introduction and sign-ups, of which will take place this week
- Homecoming will take place Oct 29th in the gym
- Ms. Awofadeju asks for parental support for our athletes and coaches

6:10PM – Ms. Awofadeju: Naming of Football Stadium

- Ms. Awofadeju introduces Ms. Andre and Coach Pat McQuaid to discuss the memorial for Dr. John LaCasse
- Coach McQuaid States that a committee was formed to discuss naming Football Filed after Dr. LaCasse prior to his passing
- Coach McQuaid discusses Dr. LaCasse's legacy project

- Coach McQuaid explains that the committee for naming the football stadium wishes to have JRL signage at the football field over the press box, under the score board and a memorial plaque for the baseball field, obtained quotes for signage
 - We will ask for School Board approval to approve the plans for naming the football field JRL Stadium
- Ms. Andre discusses her relationship with Dr. LaCasse and his role in her life, many alumni respected and honored him, he was "for kids" and so many people recognized his contributions to Nova High School
- Stakeholders acknowledged his legacy; many had shared tears and laughter while sharing of personal stories
- Discussed that there is a school committee discussing and working on a memorial tree, a plaque, and a ceremony
 - Collecting donations to assist in the On-Campus Memorial for Dr. LaCasse of which can be found on the school site through the E-store. Shared a breakdown of the cost of items:
 - Naming of the football field \$17,000
 - Memorial Tree \$1600 \$2600
 - Memorial Plaque \$800
 - Ceremonial Refreshments \$500
- On November 3rd there will be a memorial home football game to honor Dr. LaCasse
- Introduces Dr. Gutzmore

- There will be no exams in November
- FCLE will be given in December for seniors that are currently enrolled in Gov, AP Gov
