also required to wear


ID badges as well.



Safety and security are our top priorities. Please make sure to remember the following safety procedures:

- · Officers Andrade and Dittman will be returning this year.
- · All doors will be locked, including the front office door.
- · All visitors must report to the single point of entry. (front office)
- · A camera system is installed and monitored.
- · All gates will remain locked throughout the school day.
- · All visitors must go through our STAR Visitor System.
- · All visitors must have an I.D. in order to gain access to the school.
- · Visitors will not be allowed to have breakfast or lunch in the cafeteria.
- · Monthly safety drills will be conducted.
- · All parents of car riders must have a Blue Car Rider Sign to pickup
- Students must wear their I.D.s while on campus.
- · Parents must update their contact information.
- · All students should be in uniform per the Student Code of Conduct.
- Consistency with dismissal is critical. Please alert the teacher and office ASAP of any changes in writing.
- Help build your student's independence by ensuring they come to school prepared with their homework, lunch, laptops, etc. to avoid classroom interruption.
- Early student sign-outs will cease at 1:40 p.m.
- All volunteers must be approved before allowed in classrooms or on campus. Teachers will notify the office if they are expecting volunteers.

SCHOOL UNIFORMS

Country Hills Elementary School is a Unified Dress School. All students are expected to adhere to the unified dress policy.

- Recommended Attire: Collared or Polo shirts in red, white, blue or gray.
 Bottoms: khaki, blue or black
- Country Hills T-Shirts may be worn any day of the week.
- Jeans are allowable any day of the week.
- Shorts and skirts must be appropriate in length. Administration has the right to ask students to cover up if need be.
- Sweatshirts are permitted. Hoodies may be worn without the hood on during the school day.
- Closed toed shoes must always be worn for safety.

Arrival Procedures

The first bell rings at 8:05 am each morning. The gates will open

and supervision will be provided at 7:40 am each morning.

Please do not leave your child unattended before 7:40 am! Remember, all students are invited to eat breakfast at no charge. Students not eating breakfast will wait inside their designated buildings until the first bell rings at 8:05.

It is vital that all students arrive to school on-time. Teachers plan important morning activities which immerse students immediately in learning.

All gates will be locked at 8:10 am. Any student arriving after the second bell must be escorted to the front office by a parent.

There is no parking or leaving cars unattended in the Car Rider Loop or Bus Loop.

Violations will be enforced by our School Resource Officer.

For the safety of our students, we ask that parents in the arrival car lane abide by some simple safety rules:

- 1. No cell phones when dropping off or picking up your child.
- 2. Children are to exit the car from the right side(sidewalk).
- 3. Please stay in one lane, the outside land is for those cars that are parking.
- 4. Pull all the way up. The safety of your children is our utmost concern.

Car Loop Procedures



Please utilize the grade designated car loop when picking up your children.

Students will only be loaded on the passenger side of the vehicle; they will be standing at their designated number post. Vehicles **MUST** pull all the way forward in the car loop.

All vehicles picking up students are REQUIRED to hang the provided sign from the rear-view mirror. Please write the child's first and last name on the car hanger and the grade level and teacher's name. If there is more than one child, you may write multiple names or the family name. If you anticipate a relative, neighbor, or friend occasionally picking up your child, please make sure you have a car hanger for them as well.

Drivers should always remain in the car while in the car loop; use of cell phones is NOT permitted.

Parents are not permitted in the Car Loops on foot for the safety and security of our students.

Dismissal time begins at 2:10pm.

Car Loop A- Enter from Coral Springs Drive

Students in grades K-2 and Special Programs and their older siblings will be picked up at Car Loop A.

Car Loop B- Enter from Westview Drive

Students in grades 3-5 and multi-age 2/3 will be picked up at Car Loop B. Carpools are encouraged! Carpool students should go to the car loop of the youngest child in the car.

Parent Walk-Up Procedures- Located in the Bike Rack between Car Loop A and Car Loop B

Students in K-2 who are walkers must be released to an adult following these procedures.

Students in K-2 will be in the bike rack between Car Loop A and Car Loop B.

You will receive a key chain tag to write your child's name on it in order to pick up your child.

There will be a staff member at the gate calling names of the parent walk-up students.

This will ensure the safety and security of ALL students.

NO BIKES WILL BE PARKED IN BIKE RACK BETWEEN CAR LOOP A AND CAR LOOP B

Dismissal Changes

ALL dismissal changes need to be in writing. No exceptions!

Friendly Reminders

- Please Do Not Park in the Fire Lane in the bus loading zone unless it is a medical emergency.
- Children may not walk alone through the parking lot area.
- Please use the crosswalks and crossing guards when walking to and from school.
- During school-wide events please use both parking lots and North Community Park to park your cars safely.
- Please remember there is no parking on the grassy areas around the school.
- Please be sure your child's teacher has your completed dismissal permission slip.
