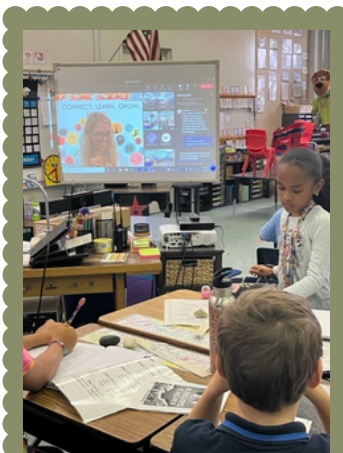
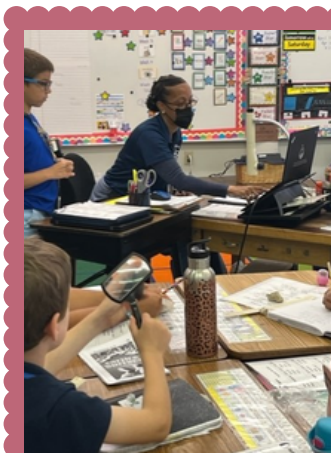

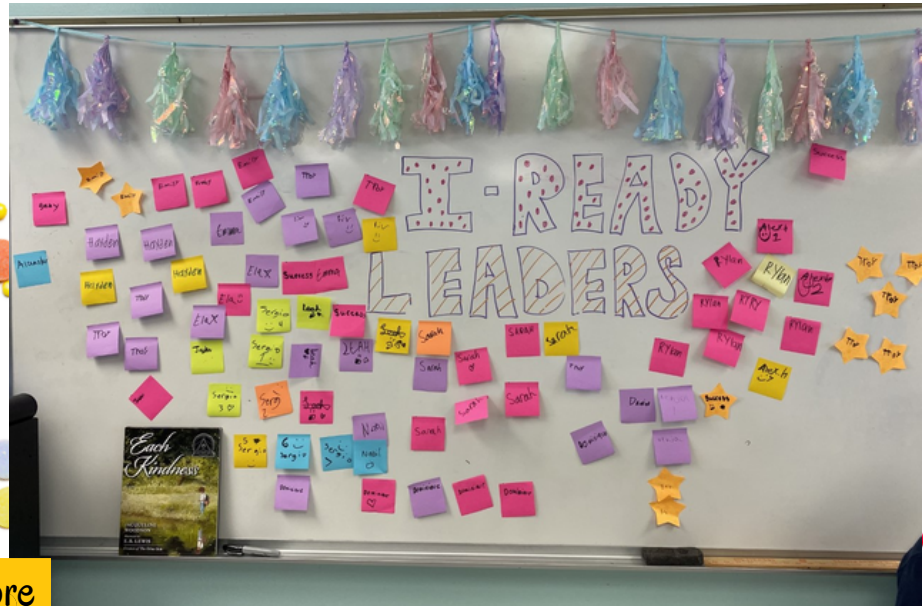

★ **President:**

The President presides at all member, executive committee, and executive board meetings. Approves all Committee plans, budgets, and communications. Coordinates PTA calendar with Principal. Represents the PTA at any outside meeting (PEC, SAF, SAC, etc) and can report to those meetings on behalf of PTA. Follows PTA bylaws in execution of duties listed and other wise assigned. Serves on Executive Committee.

★ **1st Vice President (VP1):**

The VP1 presides at all member, executive committee, and executive board meetings. Aids the President to approve all Committee plans, budgets, and communications. Coordinates PTA calendar with the Principal. Represents the PTA at any outside meeting (PEC, SAF, SAC, etc) and can report to those meetings on behalf of PTA. Updates all social media and sends out emails to members as necessary. Follows PTA bylaws in execution of duties listed and otherwise assigned. Serves on the Executive Committee.

★ **Secretary:**

Records and submits for approval to the Presidents the minutes of all meetings. Prepares all written communications (meeting agendas, emails, etc) and duties otherwise assigned. Serves on Executive Committee.

★ **Treasurer:**

Has custody of all funds. Keeps account of all receipts, expenditures, and disbursements (check requests, taxes, fees, etc) as needed. Responsible for maintenance of financial accounts and budgets according to the bylaws, and reports those statements to the PTA members at monthly meetings. Serves on Executive Committee.

★ **VP Ways and Means 1 and 2:**

Develops, plans and coordinates all fundraising events (in-house fundraiser, spirit items, etc). Works with PTA, school, staff and teachers as well as the Principal to coordinate events with staff and volunteers. Serves on Executive Committee.

★ **VP Programs:**

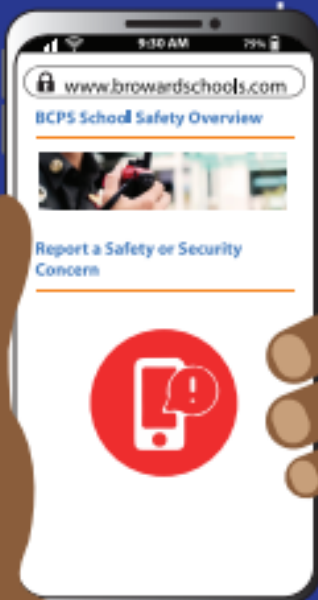
