LH = Local Honors: The District has designated this course as “Local Honors” because it contains rigor that supports the awarding of an extra quality point towards the District’s weighted grade point average (GPA), which is used for class rank. These courses, however, may not be considered “honors” for State University Admissions, NCAA Eligibility, or for Bright Futures Scholarship purposes and may not be awarded the extra quality point in these programs’ recalculated GPAs. All local honors courses are designated with “LH” in the title.

Opportunities for Dual Enrollment are available through Broward College and the University of Florida.

Personal Financial Literacy is a new graduation requirement for students who entered 9th grade in school years 2021-2022 and After. PBHS students are encouraged to take this course on FLVS. This course is also offered through Dual Enrollment at Broward College.
