The purpose of this Scholarship is to identify and reward students who have made substantial positive performance effort or change in their high school careers, as noted by attendance, attitude, grades, community service and teacher recommendations.

Eligibility Requirements

- Student must be a US Citizen or Resident alien
- North Lauderdale Resident
- Senior in High School & GPA 2.5 or better
- Must be accepted or enrolled 2 or 4 year college or technical school
- Minimum of 40 hours Community Service Completed

Award Criteria

- All applications must be submitted by: March 23, 2023
- Submit a personal Essay (no more than 600 words) on what event/person were instrumental in setting and achieving your educational goals
- A copy of your recent transcripts with GPA
- Two letters of recommendation

Selection Committee

Applications and subsequent award shall be made by a selection committee, which consists of the North Lauderdale employees and one Elected Official from the City Commission. Applicants must be received by the deadline.
