Approval of Draft Minutes – Reviewed, approved, and seconded past minutes from January, February, March, April and May 2021.

Bylaws – Explained length of term for officers, elected and installed annually in September of each year.

SAC Composition – Approved and seconded Ms. Valiente as SAC Chair.

2021 -2022 School Improvement Plan – Using various new programs, “Benchmark Advance” for Reading. Go Math for Mathematics. New math system coming 2022 -2023.

All Kg – 2 will do BAS 3 times this year. Only those that receive interventions in grades 3 – 5 will do BAS. All K-5 students will be assessed on iReady Diagnostic 3 times a year to measure growth and determine if a student needs enrichment or intervention.

New for this year I Ready has “Road Trip” incentives, short goals as they achieve levels for reading and math.

Accountability Funds for 21 - 22 – License expiring for Reflex Math used by grades 2-5. Cost of \$3295, approved and seconded.

School Recognition Funds – i.e. A+ and 5% Principal Discretion monies. Propose purchasing additional computer carts and computers to make a 1:1 ratio using \$10,000 from Principal Discretion Funds. This was approved and seconded.

SAF – Melissa Sathe SAF chair for 2021-2022 school year. SAF Bylaws were explained. Mrs. Sathe advised that she will be attending monthly School Advisory Forum meetings every month and sharing information at SAC meetings.
