# SCHOOL ENTRANCE INFORMATION – 2021-2022 KINDERGARTEN – FIFTH GRADE

### \*\*KINDERGARTEN\*\*

#### \*\*FIRST GRADE\*\*

5 years old on or before September 1, 2021 shall be eligible for admission anytime during the school year.

6 years old on or before September 1, 2021 shall be eligible for admission if the child has been enrolled in a public school or has satisfactorily completed kindergarten in a nonpublic school.

## ITEMS NEEDED AT TIME OF REGISTRATION - ALL GRADES

- a. A birth certificate (original) or other proof of age.
- b. Proof of residence such as an electric bill and water bill.
- c. Notarized Lease agreement with name and contact information of lessor and landlord. Two proofs of residence (electric bill and water bill).
- d. Proof of a medical examination that has been performed within a 12 month period prior to school registration for first-time entrance in the state of Florida.
- e. A Florida Certificate of Immunization, which includes:
  - a. Diphtheria, Tetanus, Pertussis (5)
  - b. Measles (2), Mumps and Rubella (1 each)
  - c. Hepatitis B (3)
  - d. Varicella Vaccine (Chicken Pox)
    (Two doses needed for Kindergarten thru Fifth grade)
- f. Last Report Card (showing promotion)

There is no grace period for medical requirements. No student will be admitted to school without proof of a medical examination & a Florida Certificate of Immunization that specifically shows all dates of vaccinations.

#### ADDITIONAL HEALTH INFORMATION

# **Medication Procedure:**

- 1. School must have an Authorization for Medication Form on file completed and signed by a licensed physician.
- 2. School must have a parent signature on the Medication Authorization Form.
- 3. Medications are to be administered by the school principal or his/her designee when the mediation schedule cannot be provided for before or after school when there exists an illness or disability that requires maintenance-type medication and where failure to take prescribed medication could jeopardize the student's health.
- 4. Parents should request physician to time medication dosage for non-school hours when possible.
