Important Recycling Note Regarding Trash Bags

Waste Management would like us to inform our community that any recycling that is placed inside a trash bag (unless it's clear, seethrough) will be treated as trash, and thrown into the garbage, instead of being recycled. Therefore, any recyclables that you put into your blue roll out container MUST be loose, and not in any kind of a trash bag. To help keep things clean, they recommend rinsing out all recyclables, and rinsing out your large blue roll out recycle container once every few months. It's that simple!
