Graders!



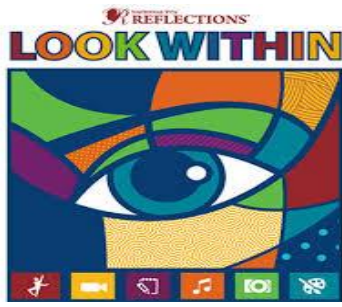

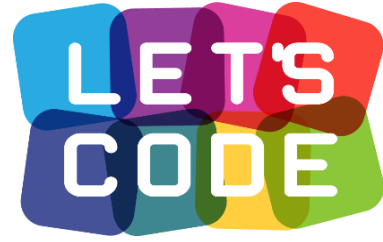
