REPORTING AN ABSENCE

This year, ECE is transitioning into a virtual Reading Across Broward program called Beanstack. Beanstack is an app found on Clever used to track student's independent reading time.

The purpose of the program is to make it easier for students to track their reading as well as keep them motivated.

Beanstack has the same expectations as Reading Across Broward- the only difference is that Beanstack is more interactive as students will earn virtual badges as they log books.

At the end of the year, students will still get Reading Across Broward certificates depending on the level they achieved (Participation, Silver, Gold).

ECE will also continue to acknowledge the students who received the Superintendent award level.

We would like to encourage everyone to try this new online system of logging their books. The paper version of Reading Across Broward will still be accepted but we highly recommend students to complete the list digitally since we are going 100% green next year.

Below are the steps you and your child can follow to log books on Beanstack:

- 1. Go to your child's dashboard on the BCPS student launch pad: https://sso.browardschools.com Login, and select the Clever icon, then click on the "Beanstack" option.
- 2. In Beanstack, click on the "Log Reading and Activities" button at the top left corner and begin logging in titles.
- 3. As your child logs reading, he or she will earn virtual badges and special recognition.



You can add money to your child's school meal account via the internet at www.myschoolbucks.com . Be sure to check your child's account often to ensure there is money available for them to purchase school lunch.
