Grab and Go Meals!


Great news! The U.S. Department of Agriculture (USDA) has extended the summer meals flexibility waiver, now allowing Broward County Public Schools to provide breakfast and lunch at no cost to all children 18 years and younger – regardless of meal eligibility status and even if they don't attend a BCPS school. Grab-and-Go meals are available at Embassy Creek, every Tuesday and Thursday from 8:30 a.m. to 9:30 a.m. while the District continues instruction through eLearning. In addition, on Fridays students may take home a frozen meal for the weekend. Meals will be available at dismissal for students who wish to pick one up.

REPORTING AN ABSENCE

Please speak clearly and slowly as we have to listen to the recording to gather the information. State your child's name, teacher, the reason, and the date they are absent. ADMINISTRATION UPDATE

Car Rider Dismissal Time Information:

We are still following staggered dismissal times for car riders. Please adhere to the dismissal times below:

K: 1:30 p.m.

1st grade: 1:45 p.m. 2-5th grade: 1:55 p.m.

Parents should not enter the East parking lot before their scheduled time. We thank you for your help with this.

Daily Wellness Check:

To ensure you are not sending a sick child to campus, we encourage you to ask these questions every morning:

- Does my child feel warm, have a fever or elevated temperature (100.4)?
- Does my child have a persistent cough, runny nose or sore throat?
- Has my child been in close, unprotected contact with anyone who has tested positive for COVID-19?
- Is my child feeling otherwise sick or ill today?

If you suspect that your child has been in close contact with a positive or potentially positive individual, please do not send your child to school until a negative PCR test has been obtained. Please keep your child home while you are waiting for these results for your child, or the close contact individual.
