Grab and Go Meals!

Great news! The U.S. Department of Agriculture (USDA) has extended the summer meals flexibility waiver, now allowing Broward County Public Schools to provide breakfast and lunch at no cost to all children 18 years and younger — regardless of meal eligibility status and even if they don't attend a BCPS school. Grab-and-Go meals are available at Embassy Creek, every Tuesday and Thursday from 11 a.m. to 1 p.m. and from 3 to 5 p.m. while the District continues instruction through eLearning.


