### **BSO Update on Safety**

The safety and wellbeing of our students is our number one priority. I ask everyone to please continue to follow the procedures that are established here at Embassy Creek to keep things flowing smoothly. As many of us know, traffic is one of our most challenging issues at the school and we continue to need your help. Please follow these expectations at all times during arrival and dismissal.

Refrain from jaywalking on SE Lake Boulevard – You will be ticketed.

Never drop your child off on SE Lake Boulevard and allow them to walk to school – You will be ticketed.

When lining up in the afternoon to pick up your child, do not line up any earlier than 1:50 PM. This creates a hardship for emergency vehicle's ability to move on SE Lake Boulevard. Remember, the gates in the back of the school do not open until 2:00 PM.

Thank you to everyone for understanding and following the procedures outlined above – Your child's safety is our number one concern and everyone should work together to keep our kids safe!
