As we move towards the end of September, so much is happening in Broward County Schools. First, the Reopening Survey is now available on your child's Clever page. Parents have until Tuesday, September 29th to complete the survey with their choice. Please know that a parent who does not complete the survey by Tuesday, September 29th will have their child's choice defaulted to "continue with eLearning at home". A parent's selection on this survey will be for the duration of the first semester of school, which ends of January 7, 2021.

Parents that select Option B of the survey, "participate in face-to-face eLearning on the school's campus", will follow the tentative dates below for bringing their child to Embassy Creek Elementary. Students in grades K - 1 are tentatively scheduled to return on Wednesday, October 14th, while students in grades 2 - 5 are tentatively scheduled to return on Tuesday, October 20th. Delivery of instruction at home and in the school will be taught through the same eLearning platform (TEAMS/Canvas) and students will receive the same curriculum regardless of the option selected.

The safety and well-being of our students and staff is always our number one priority! District has provided our school with PPE, sanitizing products, and signage for our campus. Our awesome custodial team has prepared our school for the return of our students and staff and have placed specific sanitizing procedures in place to help ensure a clean and safe learning environment for everyone. Finally, our amazing PTA has provided additional items to bring about the safest facility in Broward County

We encourage our parents who are still having a difficult time completing the survey to call or email their child's classroom teacher or grade level administrator. As many of our parents are aware, questions regarding students in grades K - 2 should be directed to Mrs. Hoover, grades 3 - 4 should contact Mrs. Dolin and parents of 5th graders can reach out to me. We will attempt to answer some your questions and assist in making the best decision possible for your child and present situation. Once final decisions are made, a TEAMS Town Hall will take place with specifics for our parents that selected either Option A or Option B. Please remember that any reopening plans that are made at Embassy Creek are contingent upon the number of students that will be on campus for eLearning.

Please know that the safety, health, happiness and of course education of your child is always our top priority and we will do everything to make our student's experience at Embassy Creek the very best possible ①
