BSO Update on Safety

The safety and wellbeing of our students is our number 1 priority. I ask everyone to please continue to follow the procedures that are established here at Embassy Creek to keep things flowing smoothly. As many of us know, traffic is one of our most challenging issues at the school and we continue to need your help. Please follow these expectations at all times during arrival and dismissal:

- Refrain from jaywalking on SE Lake Boulevard You will be ticketed
- Be mindful of the divided and marked sidewalks for bikes and walkers. Please stay in the appropriate lanes for the safety of the children and parents.
- Never drop your child off on SE Lake Boulevard and allow them to walk to school – You will be ticketed
- When lining up in the afternoon to pick up your child, do not line up any earlier than 1:30 PM. This creates a hardship for the emergency vehicles ability to move on SE Lake Boulevard. Remember, the gates in the back of the school do not open until 1:30 PM. If you choose to line up earlier than 1:30 PM, you may be ticketed.

You can add money to your child's school meal account via the internet at www.myschoolbucks.com. Be sure to check your child's account often to ensure there is money available for them to purchase school lunch.


FORGOTTEN LUNCHES/ITEMS
