



Cypress Bay Student Parking Frequently Asked Questions

Q. When will sales commence for parking for the 24-25 school year?

A. This is a first come first serve process determined by online purchase.

Spots will be assigned by order of online purchases.

Class of 2025 can purchase their decal ONLINE: May 20th @ 12:01am to May 24th @ 11:59pm.

Class of 2026 can purchase their decal ONLINE: May 29th @ 12:01am to June 3rd @ 11:59pm (if supplies last).

Q. When can the student turn in paperwork and pick-up parking decal?

- Thursday, August 7th from 9am-11am in the cafeteria
- Friday, August 8th from 11am-1pm in the cafeteria

Q. What will I need to pick up my decal?

- Copy of payment receipt
- Completed CBHS Parking Application Form
- Copy of Driver's License
- Copy of Vehicle Insurance (not expired)
- Copy of Vehicle Registration (not expired)

Q. Do I need to stress out and rush in line to pick up parking decal?

A. No. You will not need to stress out on August 7th or August 8th because you have already been assigned a parking space.

Q. Can I purchase a decal if I only have a learner's permit?

A. No, you must have a license to purchase a decal/sticker for the 24-25 school year.

Q. How many parking spaces are available for parking in the CB student lot?

A. 550 parking spaces are available on a first come/first serve basis. We will sell to Seniors first and then proceed with Juniors if supplies last.

Q. Can a friend or family member turn in paperwork and pick-up parking decal form for me if I am unable to come?

A. Yes, they can turn in the paperwork, but they will not be able to get the decal. The student whose name is on the application will need to see Mr. Wasserman to retrieve their 24-25 decal.

Q. Can Freshman and Sophomores Park in the CB student parking lot?

A. No, parking is for Juniors and Seniors only.

Q. Is a senior spot the same as having a CB parking spot?

A. NO, you must purchase a CB parking spot first. Senior spots are a fundraiser through the Senior class. A CB parking spot will cost \$57.50 for the 24-25 school year. A Senior spot allows you to paint your spot and customize it. That cost for a Senior Spot is \$50.00 for the 24-25 school year. The cost of a senior spot will be paid to the Senior class. As such, if you wanted to customize your spot as a senior for the 24-25 school year, the total cost would be \$107.50.

Q. Where do I park if I do not purchase a decal?

A. Cypress Bay does not support or endorse any off-campus parking included but not limited to the library or Vista Park. All students who park off campus are doing so at their own risk and do not fall under CBHS jurisdiction. Once students step on campus, they cannot go back to their off-campus vehicle unless signed out by a parent.
