iReady/BAS These assessment drive our instruction. All students in grades 1-5 are encouraged to complete 45 minutes each of math and reading weekly. IReady is accessible at home. Students log in with their student number. Each teacher will administer the BAS to determine every students reading level. They will share this information with you during a conference.
