**The task at hand was: Design an initiative or innovative approach that uses data to address the impacts of natural disasters.**

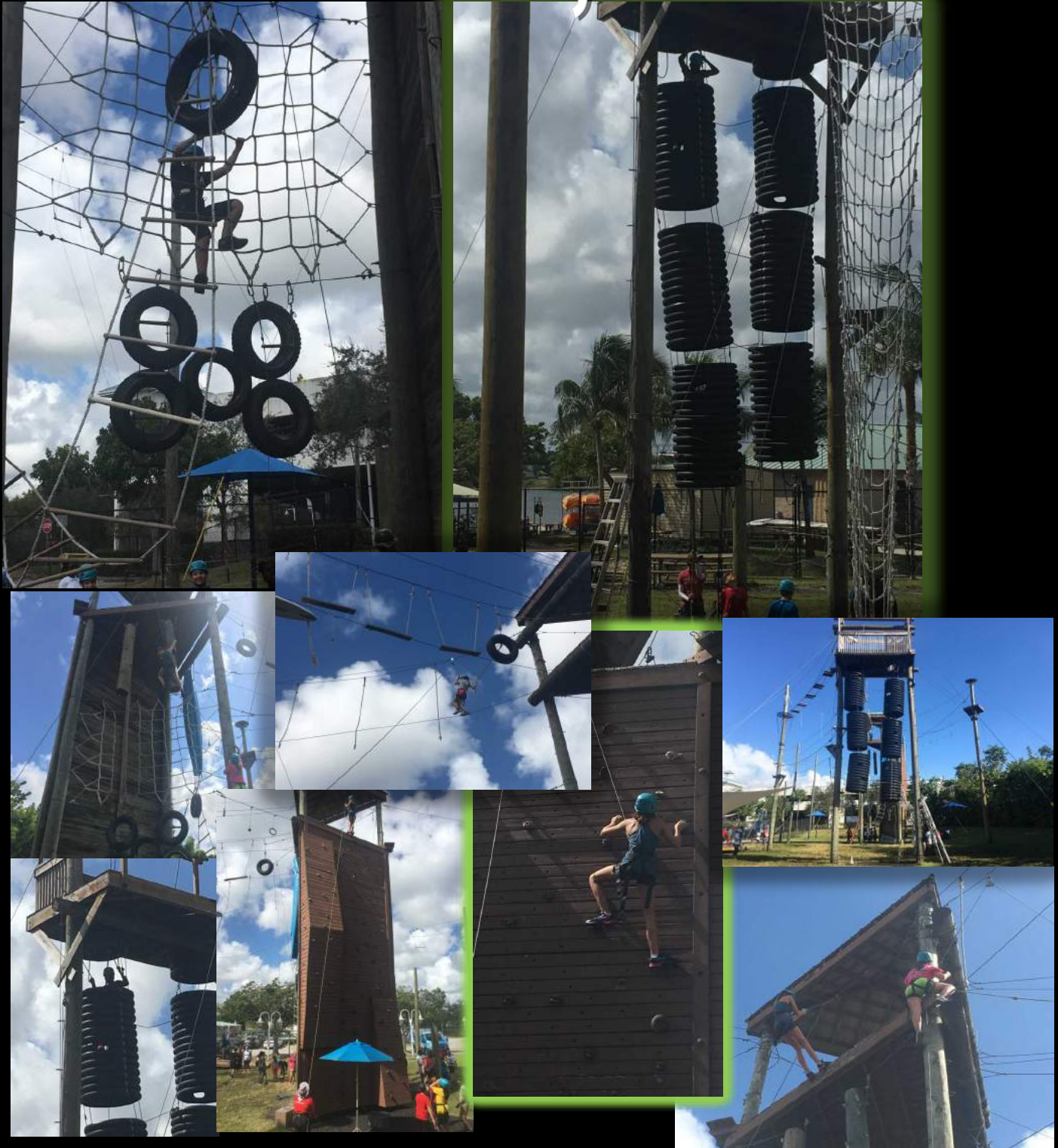
