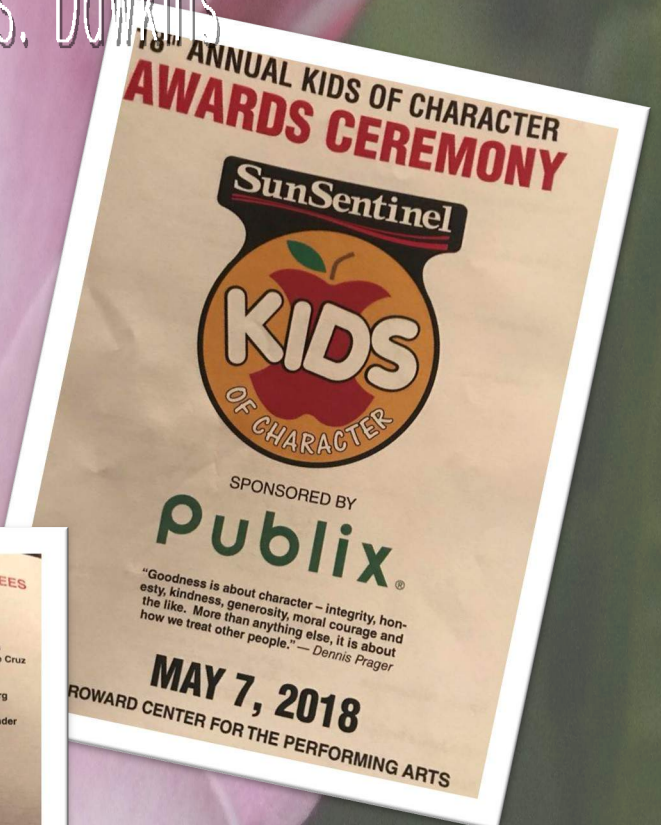

This creative project is fully funded by the Turner France Grant.

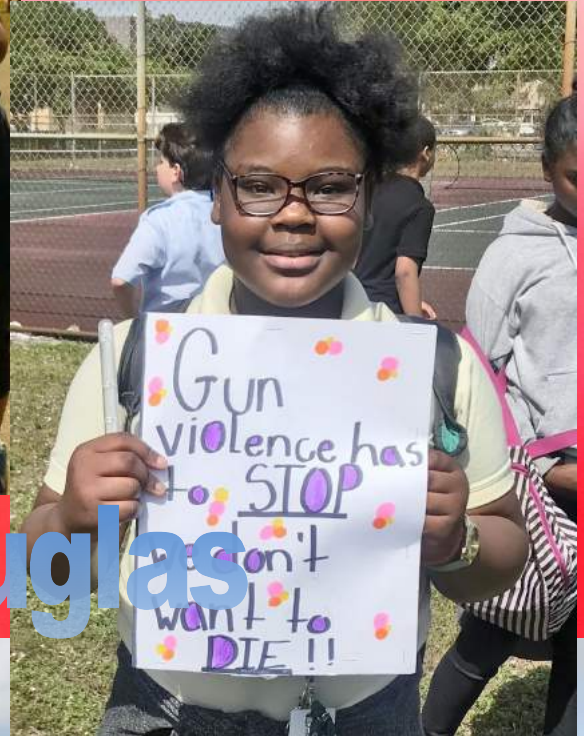


