From the Principal's Desk:

Our students, staff and families enjoyed Literacy Week! It was wonderful to see so many characters come to life at Tradewinds Elementary and students were able to share a variety of genres and authors with their peers. The decorated doors were also award winning and outstanding. Congratulations to all participating classes. Literacy night was very well attended and all students received a new book. The class with the highest attendance will receive a pizza party. On Tuesday, we also saw hundreds of 100-Day hats and even had "100-year old students" attend TWE. On Wednesday night, many third grade parents attended an informational session about the Florida Standards Assessment. It was another fantastic week at Tradewinds.

The Broward Standards Assessment (BSA) is behind us and our instructional team not only looks at student strengths and areas needing growth, but how students tested. Please encourage your child to always do their best and ask these follow up questions: How did you you think that you performed?, What strategies did you use in Math (Grades 3-5), Reading (Grades 3-5) and Science (Grade 5)?, How has your writing improved (Grades K-5)? and Did you understand what the questions were asking you to do? While the BSA was being administered, Grades K, 1 and 2 are assessing on the Benchmark Assessment System (BAS). Your child(ren)'s teachers are available to share these results as we progress monitor student academic development.

The second quarter's report cards were issued on Wednesday. Please review the results with your child(ren), set goals for improvement and return the goldenrod envelope. As always, your child(ren)'s teacher(s) are available for a conference if requested. Interim Reports for the third nine weeks will be issued on Tuesday, **February 11th**.

Tradewinds is a unified dress school and students are expected to follow the color patterns of hunter green, gold, khaki and white. As these colors may be a bit challenging to find during certain seasons, students are permitted to wear variations of greens and yellows. Additionally, our PTA sells school spirit items and clothing.

For your convenience, staff accepts students on the car line beginning at 7:15. The first bell rings at 7:55 and all students are to be at their seats and ready to learn by the 8:00 bell.
