On Tuesday, Grade 4 and 5 students will take the FSA English and Language Arts Writing Assessment and on Tuesday and Wednesday, our Grade 3 students will take the FSA Reading Assessment (Sessions 1 and 2). This will "kickoff" a few months of district and state testing (the FSA Testing schedule is outlined below). Even Grade 1 and 2 students will take their Primary Reading Assessment on May 14th and 15th. Each and every day, please encourage your child(ren) to do their best and to use all of their strategies. Being punctual and ready to learn each day is essential to your child(ren)'s success. Please also remember that Tradewinds has a free breakfast program open to all students from 7:30-7:55 a.m.

Tradewinds is seeking immediate assistance - please contact Mrs. Rosie if you are able to proctor for some or all of this year's FSA testing. All proctors must be approved through the district's volunteer program and it's not too late to submit an application. Your time is much appreciated.
