This benchmark is also an indicator of how students will fare on the spring's Florida Standards Assessment (FSA). The schedule is as follows:

January 14th and 15th - BSA ELA Reading (Grades 3-5)

January 21st and 22nd - BSA Science (Grade 5)


January 28th and 29th - BSA Mathematics (Grades 3-5)

Join us for tomorrow morning's Read and Rise Literary Conversation for Kindergarten to Grade 2 parents from 9-12. The District's Title One Department will host this session at our school. This is a great opportunity for our parents to learn how to support their child(ren) in reading, engage in meaningful conversation about story telling, and also to receive free books.
