Coral Springs High School will be implementing Super Testing sessions in order to efficiently conduct state-mandated exams with minimal impact on classroom instruction. The primary function of the school during Super Testing days will be to ensure a safe and secure environment with minimal disruption to students.

The Super Testing will occur on the following days:

10th grade ELA Reading	7:40 AM to 9:40 AM
9th grade ELA Reading	9:30 AM to 11:40 AM

Tuesday, May 14th and Wednesday, May 15th

Algebra 1 EOC	7:40 AM to 9:20 AM
Geometry EOC	9:30 AM to 11:40 AM

Thursday, May 16th

Biology EOC and US History EOC	7:40 AM to 11:40 AM
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Students who are scheduled to take one of the above exams must attend on the appropriate Super Testing day. While attendance is only required for students testing, other students may voluntarily attend review sessions for End of Course (EOC) exams and Advanced Placement (AP) exams. These review sessions are entirely optional, but we highly encourage your child to attend. Also, students enrolled in our on-campus Florida Virtual School (FLVS) credit recovery course(s) will have an opportunity for additional time to work toward course completion.

On Super Testing days, students are dismissed at 11:40 AM with the exception of May 9, 2019, which is a district Early Release Day. On May 9th the dismissal time will be 12:30 PM. Please note that there are no sign-outs, and students are not permitted to bring backpacks on Super Testing days.
