Identification Badges

- While on campus, all students are required to wear ID badges at all times.

Gates

- Once the school day begins, all perimeter gates will be secured.
- All visitors must enter through our main parking lot on Sample Road where they will be asked to
 present ID and purpose of visit prior to entering the lot. Once on campus, all visitors will park in
 a visitor spot, enter through the single point of entry, register through the Raptor system and
 receive a visitor badge.

Arrival and Dismissal

Arrival:

- The Middle Gate on Rock Island will open at 7:00 am and close at 7:40 am. After that, parents must drop off students at the main parking lot (front of school).
- The student parking lot will open at 6:45 am and close at 7:40 am. Students who are consistently late may have their parking privileges revoked.
- All students will enter the school through two locations in the morning:
 - Main cafeteria doors (front of school)
 - West end doors of main building (parent drop off & student drivers)

Dismissal:

- The Middle Gate on Rock Island will open at 2:30 pm and close at 3:10 pm.
- The student parking lot will open at 2:40 pm and close at 3:10 pm.
- All students not participating in a school-sponsored activity must be off campus by 3:10 pm.
- Student athletes must report to the designated area as assigned by their coaches.

Law Enforcement Personnel:

• In addition to our District security personnel, there are two Coral Springs School Resource Officers assigned to report to our campus on a full-time basis.

Drills:

 We will be conducting all state required monthly drills. Appropriate notification will be provided for all drills.
